Participation Terms and Conditions

All parties interested in becoming a participant of the Australian Energy Storage Alliance (**AES Alliance**) must submit an application for participation via the online portal.

Participant applications must be approved by the AES Alliance.

AES Alliance may require an applicant to provide further information before making a determination on acceptance of participation.

AES Alliance is owned and managed by Exhibitions and Trade Fairs Pty Ltd (ETF).

Participation eligibility

Participation with the AES Alliance is open to anyone interested in energy storage and organisations active in the energy storage industries.

Participants shall be entitled to receive all benefits relevant to their Participation Level. The Participation Levels are:

Subscriber (any individual, group or organisation interested in energy storage)

Subscribers to the AES Alliance receive:

- News on Energy Storage (Australia and Global);
- Regular updates on energy storage events;
- Case Study details; and
- Information on energy storage related topics.

Contributor (companies and organisations active in energy storage)

Contributor level is available for Australian companies or organisations active in energy storage at the commercial, research or advocacy level. Participant fees

Participation of AES Alliance is free of charge to all Participants until June 30, 2015.

Participant details

Participant details will be recorded on an internal AES Alliance Participant register. This includes:

- Information provided by Participants in the application
- the date upon which the Participants became Participants
- the participation level applicable to that Participant
- the date upon which any Participant ceased to be a Participant.

Participation Termination

Participation ceases if the Participant:

- resigns as a participant by giving notice in writing;
- in the case of a body corporate, an order is made to wind-up or dissolve the member or it is unable to pay its debts as and when they are payable;
- AES Alliance determines that the Participant ceases to satisfy the relevant participation level for participation; or

- engages in any conduct which, in the reasonable opinion of AES Alliance is unbecoming of a member or prejudicial or adverse to the interests of AES Alliance.

Upon termination of participation, participant details will be removed from the AES Alliance Participant register.

Participation Term

All participation terms are for a 12 month period and are automatically renewed annually on the anniversary date of acceptance of the Participants application to become a participant for an additional 12 month period. Participation is renewed by email to the email address provided by the Participant.

These terms and conditions and the matters contemplated by it are governed by the laws of New South Wales, Australia and the parties irrevocably and unconditionally submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of New South Wales, Australia in regard to any dispute. These terms and conditions comprise the entire agreement between the parties. A provision or a right created under this Agreement may not be waived or varied except in writing and the waiver or failure of either party to exercise any right provided under these terms and conditions

will not be deemed a waiver of any further right. In these terms and conditions; the singular includes the plural and vice versa; headings are for reference and do not affect meaning; "including" is not a word of limitation; a reference to a clause or Attachment is to a clause of or attachment to these Terms unless specified otherwise; no rules of construction will apply to the disadvantage of a party who put forward or any part; any part which is invalid, unenforceable or void at law will be severed to the extent invalid, unenforceable or void and the remainder will remain in full force and effect; and the consent of ETF may be withheld or given on conditions in its absolute discretion. ETF reserves the right to vary these terms and conditions at any time. All rights not expressly granted in these terms and conditions are reserved by ETF.
